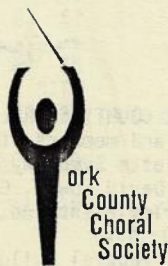

The YCCS was formed in January of 1982 with the convocation of a large group of volunteer singers from the York County area. The purpose of the society is to prepare and perform the choral masterworks, having in its repertory Handel's MESSIAH, Brahms's A GERMAN REQUIEM, Schubert's MASS IN G, Poulenc's GLORIA, Mozart's REQUIEM, to name a few, and a number of smaller works ranging from the 16th to the 20th century. Besides offering the populace with an outlet for artistic creativity, the society adds to the community a wealth of excellence through and for its people. Admission is by simple audition with rehearsals being held Thursday evenings at Oakland Baptist Church in Rock Hill.

THE FOUNDERS

Dr. DAVID LOWRY came to Winthrop College in 1965 to the post of College Organist and has risen through the ranks of the academic community to professor of music. His professional career has been closely associated with the church, as a practicing musician and in international leadership of professional church organizations. He is immediate past president of the Association of Anglican Musicians and frequently appears as accompanist, concert organist and lecturer. Co-founder Dr. SHIRLEY FISHBURNE serves as accompanist for the society. She received her education at Winthrop College and at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. She teaches piano and organ and has been a lecturer at Winthrop College in music education.
